How to Map Network Drives with Windows 2000/XP

General Steps:

1. Right click on "My Computer" to open a menu, then select "Map Network Drive..."



2. Change the "Drive:" and "Folder:" to match the drive and folder you wish to map. The picture shows what to enter for mapping the "N:" drive.

	Windows can help you connect to a shared network folder and assign a drive letter to the connection so that you can access the folder using My Computer.
