Information Technology Training Center Procedures

The Information Technology Training Center (ITTC), located in Room 163 of Jacob T. Stewart, provides hands-on training for various microcomputer and Banner applications to all University faculty/staff. All sessions are conducted in an interactive classroom environment in an instructor-led format that ensures close interaction between instructor and participant.

Classes on microcomputer and Banner applications are offered each semester. Schedules of training are e-mailed to faculty and staff as well as published to the GSU Website. Upon request, members of the Grambling-Ruston community can receive a copy of the training calendar.

Registration

One may register simply by registering online or calling extension 6147. Registration logs of attendance are maintained for all course offerings.

Documentation

Documentation and other training materials are provided for all workshops. Participants are allowed to keep the documentation. Each participant is assigned a computer and performs all class exercises. If so desired, participants may save exercises on a storage device (USB, floppy disk, CD) or email them to their email accounts.
