COB Criteria for COB Collaborator of the Year

In appreciation of the support, mentoring, co-researching and guidance to our less published faculty, the Collaborator of the Year Award is established to highlight the significance and importance of this activity. The COB faculty member who in conjunction with other faculty members assists in the production of the most refereed journal articles, proceedings, book chapters and other ICs shall be named the COB Collaborator of the Year and receive the \$1,000 cash award that goes with it. If the committee of Department Heads and Dean considers that the contest results in a tie, the tied candidates shall split the award.

Nomination Process

• Faculty members may be nominated each year until winning the award. Faculty members may nominate themselves or be nominated by other faculty members including the Department Head.

Eligibility

• Once a faculty member has received the collaborator award, he/she will not be eligible for two years following the award.

Criteria

 Assist in the production of the most refereed journal articles, proceedings, book chapters and other ICs.
