Admission Information and Requirements

Admission to Grambling State University BSN program is contingent upon clearance by the Louisiana State Board of Nursing and satisfactory results of a drug screen. Information on both reports will be provided upon acceptance. The Department of Nursing has the discretion to deny acceptance based on information contained in either of these two reports.

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The Louisiana State Board of Nursing (LSBN) requires all applicants to complete an application for approval to enroll in a clinical nursing course and an authorization for a criminal background check. Applicants who have been charged with, pled guilty, or nolo contendere to, convicted of, or committed a criminal offense that involves a crime of violence or distribution of drugs may be denied the right to practice nursing as a student in Louisiana.

Graduation from Grambling State University Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) provides eligibility for students seeking licensure through the LSBN as a registered nurse (RN).

Admission into the nursing program is not automatic.

2. APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION TO GRAMBLING STATE UNIVERSITY

Students who are not currently enrolled at Grambling State University must first apply and be accepted to the university. You may apply to Grambling State University via the Admissions Office link at www.gram.edu. If you experience difficulties or have questions regarding the admission process, contact the Admissions Office at 318-274-6183.

3. APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION TO SCHOOL OF NURSING BSN PROGRAM

The application for admission should be completed accurately and returned to the nursing school, in person, at Grambling State University School of Nursing BSN Program. At the time the application is presented, the applicant must sign up for a time and date to take the ATI TEAS. Applications sent through the U. S. mail will not be accepted. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered for admission to the School of Nursing.

4. OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS

Students must submit <u>OFFICIAL</u> transcripts from all colleges and universities attended to Grambling State University Admission Office and Grambling State University School of Nursing (GSUSON) by the application deadline. If your application does not reach these areas by the application deadline, your application will be considered incomplete and will not be considered for admission. It is the student's responsibility to have all of his/her transcripts, from all colleges/universities attended, forwarded to Grambling State University Admission Office and the School of Nursing in the allotted time.

GSUSON BSN program admission requirements:

- a. Must have completed all required non-nursing courses by end of the semester of application
- b. Must have an overall grade point average (GPA) of 2.8 in pre-nursing studies.
- c. Must have a grade of no less than a "C" or higher and a GPA of 2.8 in all science courses: Pathophysiology 225, Chemistry 105, Chemistry 107, Biology 207, Biology 207L, Biology 208, Biology 208L, Microbiology 304.
- d. ACT score of 21 or SAT score of 1060 1090.

5. ACT/SAT SCORES

The student must submit <u>OFFICIAL</u> ACT/SAT scores to the Grambling State University Admission Office, as well as, Grambling State University School of Nursing. Students applying for the GSUSON must have a score of twenty-one (21) or greater on the ACT or a score of 1060 – 1090 or greater on the SAT. Applications will not be considered for admission if the student has an ACT score of less than 21 or a SAT score of less than 1060. The last ACT test date to qualify for fall admission is April 4, 2020. The last SAT test date to qualify for fall admission is March 14, 2020.

6. TEAS SCORE

The Grambling State University School of Nursing requires that all students take the ATI TEAS to determine eligibility for admission to the professional component of the BSN program. GSUSON **recommends** that the TEAS be taken at this university. If the student has taken the TEAS exam at another college/university within a year and does not wish to retake the exam, it is the student's responsibility to have their **OFFICIAL** TEAS score sent to GSUSON by ATI only (**scores will not be accepted from the student**). **The TEAS score must be sent to and reach the GSUSON prior to the application deadline. No more than two recorded attempts will be accepted.**

To be successful on the TEAS, a student must complete the exam with a score 64% or greater. Should the student be unsuccessful on the first attempt, the student can retake the TEAS for a second attempt only. It is recommended that the student waits at least 30 days between tests in order to remediate. **Successful TEAS scores are good for only one year.** (See attached dates and times for TEAS).

<u>TEAS Payment:</u> The student must create an account and register with ATI prior to scheduled day of the TEAS. Upon entry to the testing area, payment must be submitted per credit card or debit card to ATI by the student or authorized user. GSUSON is not responsible for payment of the TEAS exam. The ATI TEAS exam cost per student is \$65.00.

Please have the full amount on your credit or debit card prior to entering the testing area. If a student does not have the payment for the exam, the student will have to reschedule their exam.

7. BSN TRANSFER STUDENTS

Students who have been previously enrolled in or are transferring from another professional school of nursing must secure a letter of good standing from the Dean/Chairperson or Director of that nursing school in order to be considered for acceptance into the Grambling State University School of Nursing program. All transfer students must meet all admission requirements. The letter must be sent directly to the GSUSON at this address:

8. NOTIFICATION TO APPLICANTS

Applicants will be notified, by mail, of their admission status by the end of May. No information of acceptance or denial to the program will be given to any applicant by phone or electronic messaging. Official letters will be sent from Grambling State University School of Nursing BSN Program only.

Applicants must indicate, in writing, their acceptance by the date stated in their acceptance letter in order to secure their place in the program. Students accepted <u>MUST</u> be available to return to campus in June for SON & LSBN requirements as scheduled.

Students who accept their admission to the GSUSON must complete further requirements:

- a. Health History, Physical Examination, TB Skin Test and Immunizations
- b. CPR
- c. Criminal Background Check and Fingerprint Cards
- d. Drug test
- e. Uniform purchase
- f. Lab kit purchase
