Tentative High School Day Agenda

For planning purposes, the following provides a “preview” of the day:

7:00 a.m. - 9:20 a.m. Arrival at Tiger Village Club House for Registration and Campus Tours

- Campus tours for individuals or small groups will be on GSU shuttle bus.
- Campus tours for groups will be conducted on the bus upon arrival.
- If arriving by bus, **ONLY CHAPARONE** will get off bus in front of the building. (Tour Guide will board bus and greet students while bus awaits return of chaperone with registration packets).
- The Campus Tour will be conducted after the chaperone re-boards bus with packets.
- If arriving by car or passenger van, proceed to designated parking. Then come to Clubhouse to pick up registration packet and board shuttle bus for campus tour.
- After campus tours, students will be dropped off at the Hobby Assembly Center and bus will proceed to designated parking area.
- **If you did not pre-register, or if you need to pay for additional registrations, you must stop at the Club House and get a registration form to take to the Cashier at the Assembly Center. Bring receipt to Club House to receive registration packet(s).**
