

### **\*Meal Plans**

Meal plans include 14 meals per week, with \$210 Tiger Bucks or 19 meals per week with \$150 Tiger Bucks or 7 meals per week with \$400 Tiger Bucks. Tiger Bucks are used to eat in the food court and the C-Store in the Jacob T. Stewart Building.

**\*Mailboxes** are required for on-campus residents.

**Once registered, all fees will be assessed to students' accounts.**

### **Book Vouchers**

Students with available credit balances up to \$1500.00 are provided electronic access to the balances at the GSU bookstore.

### **Credit Balance Refunds**

#### **Refund Policy**

Students who officially withdraw on or before the 14<sup>th</sup> class day during Fall and Spring semesters and 7<sup>th</sup> class day for Summer semesters will receive 100% of tuition and fees. Refer to refund policy under Tuition and Fees on the GSU website.

#### **Payments**
