- 1. Payroll Deductions. Payroll deductions allow the donor to make monthly installments on the amount pledged. The Payroll deductions will begin January 2019 and can be deducted Bi-Weekly or Monthly through December of 2019, or as specified on the Pledge Form. Employees can specify a one-time payroll deduction for a specified amount. Payroll Deduction Forms should be submitted to Human Resources in room 148 of Long Jones Hall.
- One-time donation. If you would like to make a one-time donation, you may also write a personal check, use a credit/debit card or bring cash with the Pledge Card to the Cashier's window in Long Jones Hall. All checks should be made payable to United Way of Northeast Louisiana.
