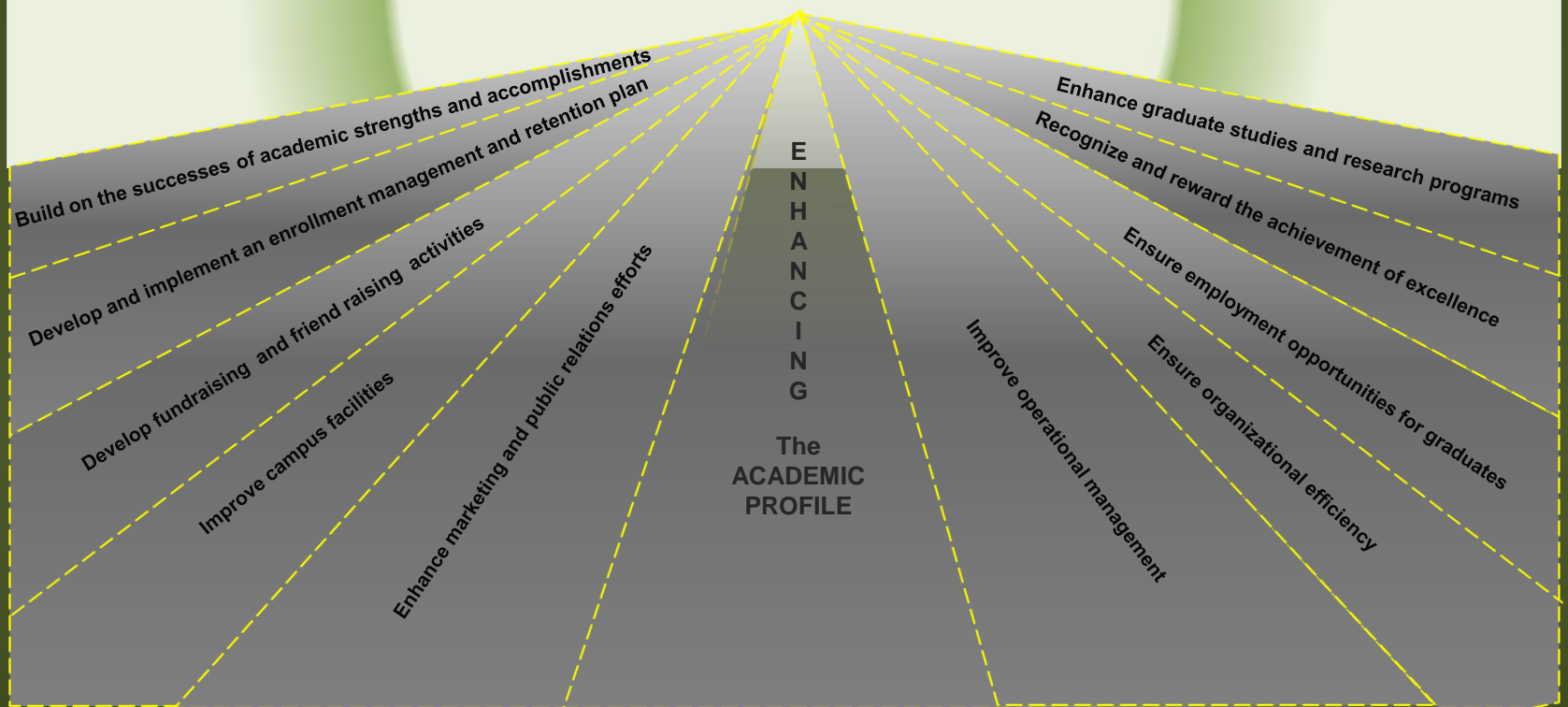

What do we require?

❑ High School Curriculum

- ❑ **19** units from *Required Core 4 Curriculum*
 - ❑ **English I, English II, English III, English IV (4)**
 - ❑ **Algebra I or Applied Algebra IA & IB, Algebra II, Geometry, and one additional unit (4)**
 - ❑ **Biology, Chemistry, and two units: (4)**
 - ❑ **Civics or AP American Government, Free Enterprise or Economics, American History, and two units: (4)**
 - ❑ **Fine Arts Survey or one unit: (1)**
 - ❑ **Foreign Language (two units from same language) or 2 Speech courses (2)**

What do we require?

❑ **Minimum HS GPA**

- ❑ Overall **2.0** GPA (on 4.0 scale)

❑ **Minimum of One Developmental Course**

- ❑ Students must have a minimum test score of:

- ❑ ACT English- **18** or ACT Math- **19**

OR

- ❑ SAT Verbal- **450** or SAT Math- **460**

OR

- ❑ COMPASS Writing- **68** or COMPASS Algebra- **40**

One of the Following:

☐ HS GPA

☐ 2.0

☐ Test Score

☐ ACT Composite- 20

OR

☐ SAT Combined- 940

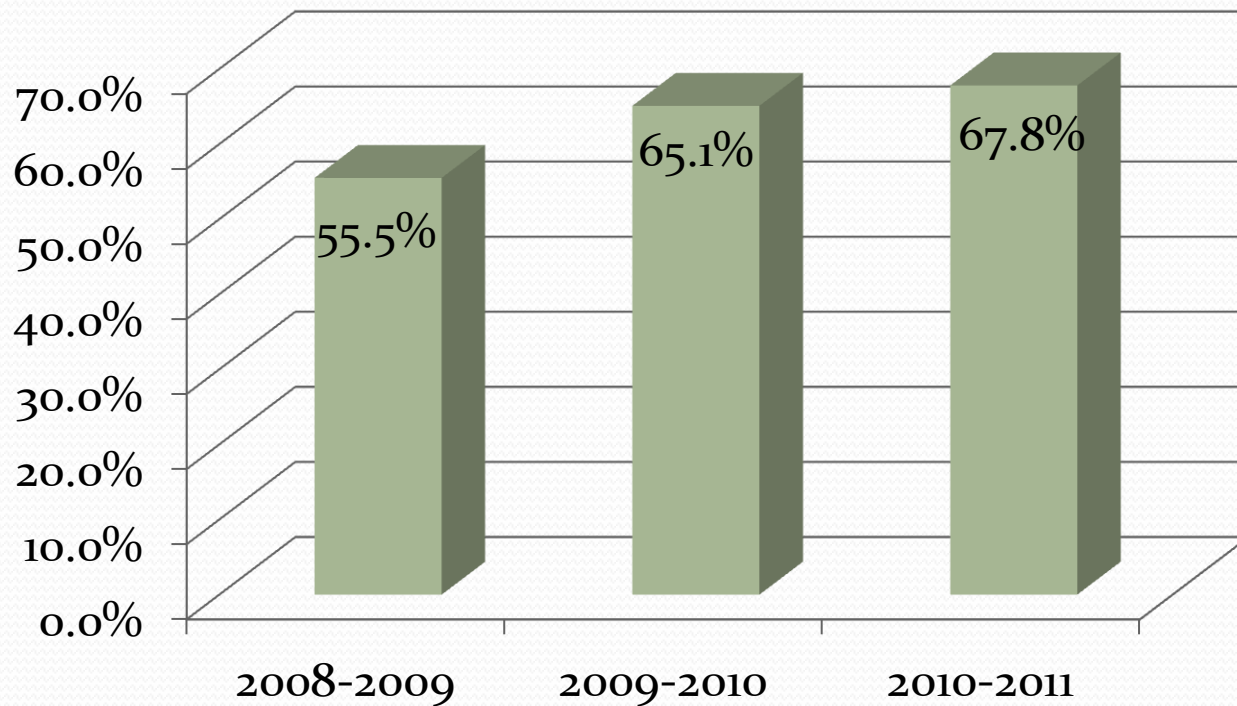

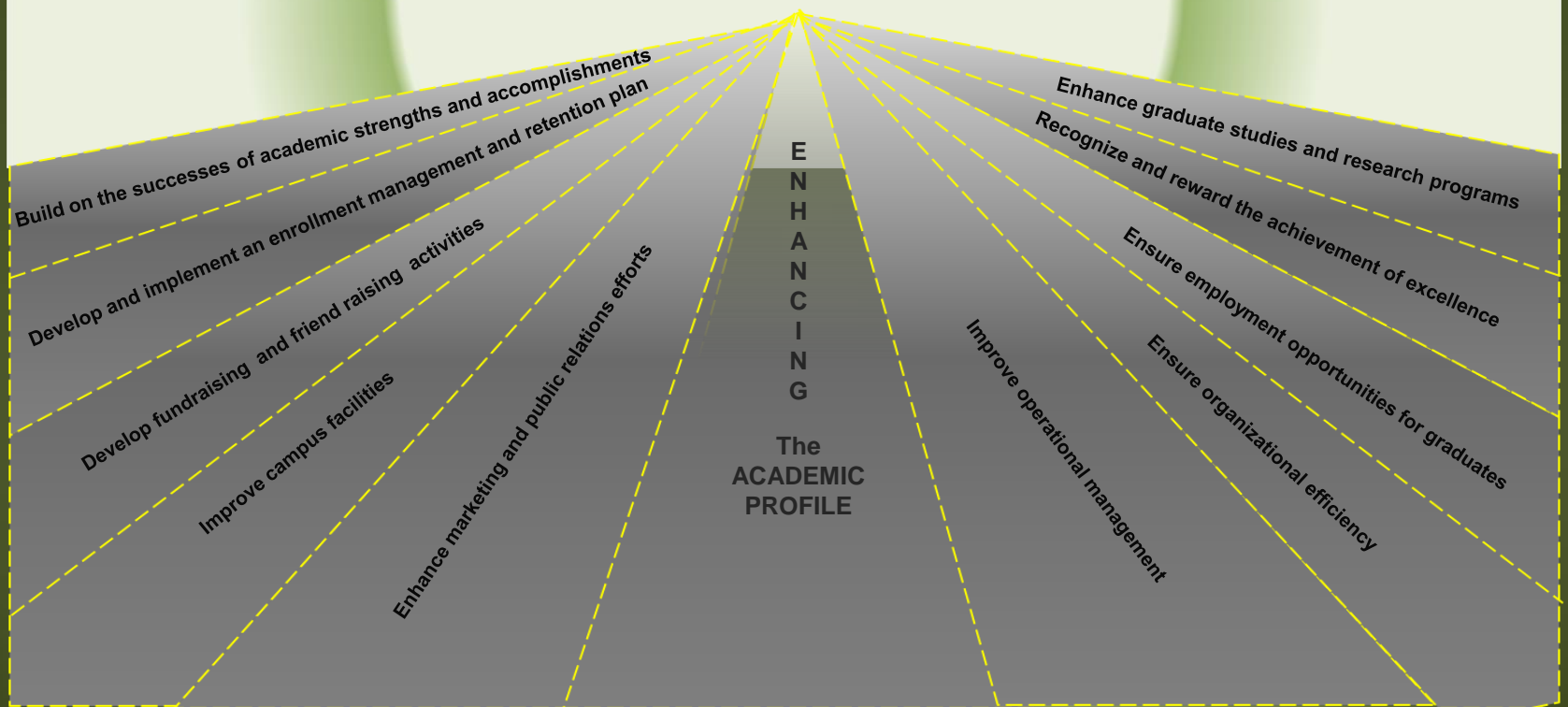
