GSU Promissory Note. Available when students and parents have been denied all other financing options. A maximum of 25% of the current term

charges assessed for Tuition & Fees, Room and Board may be financed at a processing fee of \$50 plus 6% interest per annum.

### Emergency Loans

GSU discontinued emergency loans effective with the 2006 first summer session.

### Credit Balance Refunds

Early Registration Refunds. Students that complete registration by August 1<sup>st</sup> and attend at least one class during the first two (2) class days will receive their credit balance refund by the seventh (7<sup>th</sup>) class day.

Late Registration Refunds. Students that have not completed registration by August 1<sup>st</sup> will receive the first credit balance refund within 14 days after the 14<sup>th</sup> class day.

Refund Policy. Students who officially withdraw on or before the 14<sup>th</sup> class day during fall and spring semesters and 7<sup>th</sup> class day for summer terms will receive 100% of tuition and fees. Refer to refund policy under Tuition and Fees on the GSU website.

Payments. All credit balance refunds, stipends, and student paychecks are made via Chase E-Funds debit cards issued to new students at the start of the semester by the GSU Cashiers.

Dormitory fees are assessed and payable on a per term basis.

Apartment Fees require a one year lease payable in the fall and spring terms.

Meal Plans include meals per week of 14 with \$160 Tiger Bucks or 19 with \$100 Tiger Bucks. Tiger Bucks are use to eat in the food court or the C-Store in Jacob T Steward Building.

Mailboxes are required for on-campus housing.

Housing Deposit. Deposits are generally paid once and are refundable upon graduation or upon exiting the residence hall without plans to return. Deposits will be paid net of room damages, if any. Repair cost in excess of the deposit will be billed to the students.
