

Purpose of Pre-F reshman A cademy

The Pre-Freshman Academy is a two week enrichment program designed to increase the mathematics literacy and proficiency of the participating students. A further aim is to increase student academic success in the pursuit of a bachelor of science degree in a science, technology, engineering, or mathematics (STEM) discipline.

Participating students will engage in the manipulation of mathematical concepts and methods for solving problems that are often encountered in STEM areas. Students will interpret algebraic concepts and use these concepts to analyze data obtained in a science laboratory setting. Additionally, study skills that are vital to success in STEM areas will be highlighted.

Program Eligibility

- ♦ Must be admitted to Grambling State University (GSU) for the fall semester.
- Must plan to enroll as a student at GSU during the fall semester and major in a science or mathematics field.
- Must be a United States Citizen.

A ccommodations

- Participants will receive complimentary housing on the campus of Grambling State University during the two week session, including meals.
- Participants will receive a \$400 stipend and a \$500 textbook award. The textbook award is for use during the academic year.
- One two week session is available to 50 applicants.
