Each prospective graduate student of the Sport Administration Program (SPA) must provide the following items prior to program enrollment (make copies, as applicable, for your personal information file).

- A completed and submitted original application for Graduate School enrollment, including the appropriate application processing fee.
- Three (3) letters of recommendation that address academic ability, interpersonal skills, integrity, and written/oral communication effectiveness. Letters cannot be from a relative.
- Two official copies of transcripts from all colleges or universities attended. Course descriptions will also be needed for accurate transcript evaluation when courses are to be considered for transfer credit.
- 4. Official scores from the Graduate Record Examination (GRE).

SPA faculty members are available to assist with the academic matriculation of students; the objective is to have students perform at the highest level possible or have them to be the best that they can be.
