**Degree Program Admission Requirements**

Candidates seeking program admission must fulfill the following criteria:

- \_\_\_\_\_ Must be admitted to College of Education or College of Arts & Sciences
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Apply for Admission** - Must complete a Degree Program Application
- \_\_\_\_\_ **GPA** - Have a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.50 (4.00 scale) at time of admission request
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Residency** - must have earned at least 36 semester hours (including all 100 and 200 level education courses)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **PRAXIS** - Evidence of the following minimum scores on the Praxis I: Pre-Professional Skills Tests (PPST®): Reading, 176; Writing, 175; Mathematics, 175 **OR** an ACT composite score of 22 or a SAT combined verbal and math score of 1030.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Interview** - Successful formal interview with the Portal II Committee
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Demonstration of competency in writing** (submitted at least one week before the interview)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Submission of a completed Professional Conduct Form**
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Complete Disposition Inventory #2**
- \_\_\_\_\_ **ED 201** – Must have completed at least one
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Taskstream Account** [www.taskstream.com](http://www.taskstream.com)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Background Check**

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**Next Steps - Eligibility for Student Teaching (Clinical Practice)**

- To become eligible to student teach, a candidate must meet all of the Clinical Practice requirements at the time of application and complete a total of 180 hours of observation and participation.
- ED 201 – Must have completed at least three to graduate.
