This is to report that the Council on Accreditation of Parks, Recreation, Tourism, and Related Professions, has determined the following conditions have been met for the continued accreditation of Grambling State University until 2024.

The following conditions have been satisfied:

- 3.02 Provide evidence of the appointment of a Leisure Studies Program Coordinator at the rank of Associate Professor or above with tenure.
- 7.01.04 a, b, c and 7.02.04 Provide evidence of how assessment results for these four standards impact programmatic decisions.
- 7.03.02, 7.03.03, 7.03.04 Provide evidence of performance measures, assessment results and evidence of how results impact programmatic decisions.

Accreditation will be valid until the program's next review in fall 2024. The program can expect an accreditation visit between the months of January – April 2024. To maintain accreditation, the institution must also comply with the Council's requirements for timely submission of annual reports.
