Note 1: The placement exam is an "adaptive" exam which takes approximately 45 minutes to 2 hours to complete. Only required students will take the exam. Those students will be notified via email or phone. Please bring an official photo ID for admittance. Parents are not allowed in the testing center during this period. Please leave all book bags and cell phones in your room.

Note 2: Please secure on-campus housing prior to arrival. Students who register for the Early Registration session on August 9, 2014, **MUST** have all housing requirements paid prior to arrival or on-campus housing will **NOT** be available.
