Don't Ignore It! Report It!

Slips, trips and falls are among the most common causes of accidents and injury at work.

Visitors may also be at **risk**, both inside and outside premises under GSU control.

Trips and falls can happen when people lose their balance after their feet collide with objects.

Common tripping hazards in the workplace include:

- Damaged or worn carpets, rugs, and mats
- Uneven flooring
- Cluttered walkways
