STUDENT INSURANCE REQUIREMENT POLICY- DOMESTIC/INTERNATIONAL

I. PURPOSE/OBJECTIVE

To ensure that Grambling State University (GSU) students have health and/or sickness insurance coverage while attending Grambling State University.

II. STATEMENT OF POLICY

Due to the extremely high cost of health care in the United States and the importance of health insurance coverage, the university requires all students to have insurance coverage throughout the school year. This requirement excludes faculty and staff who are enrolled in classes. These students will be enrolled in the college- endorsed Student Insurance Plan(s) and the cost will be billed to their student account upon enrollment each semester UNLESS proof of other health insurance coverage is furnished. The current plans consist of Accident and Sickness coverage for International Students and Accident coverage for Domestic Students.

- A. All students enrolled for classes at Grambling State University are eligible to enroll in the plan.
- B. Coverage will become invalid for students who leave school within 31 days of their effective date of coverage.
