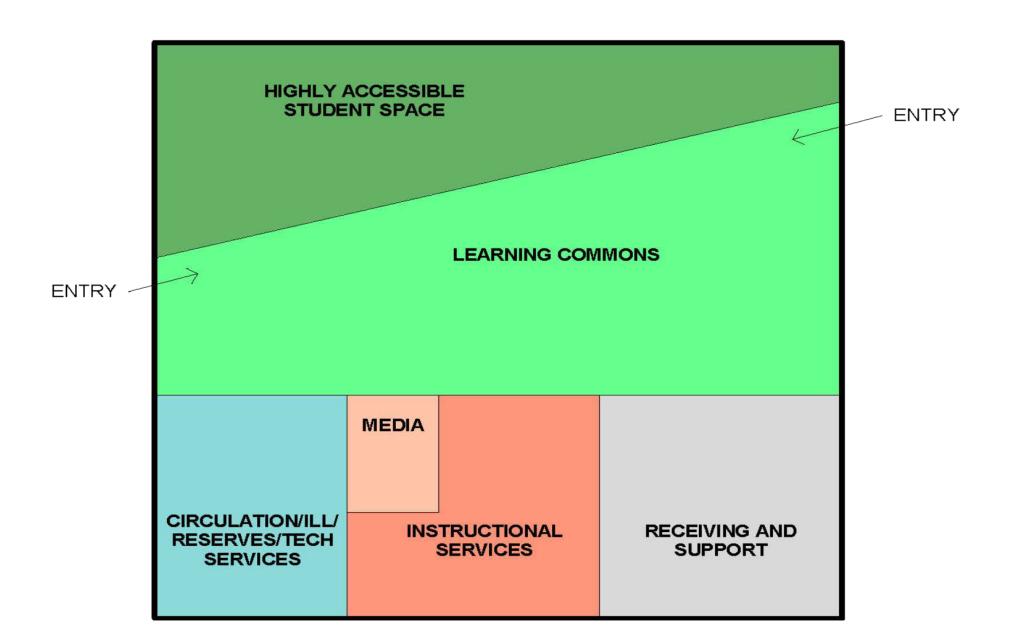
LIBRARY CONCEPT: SITE PLAN



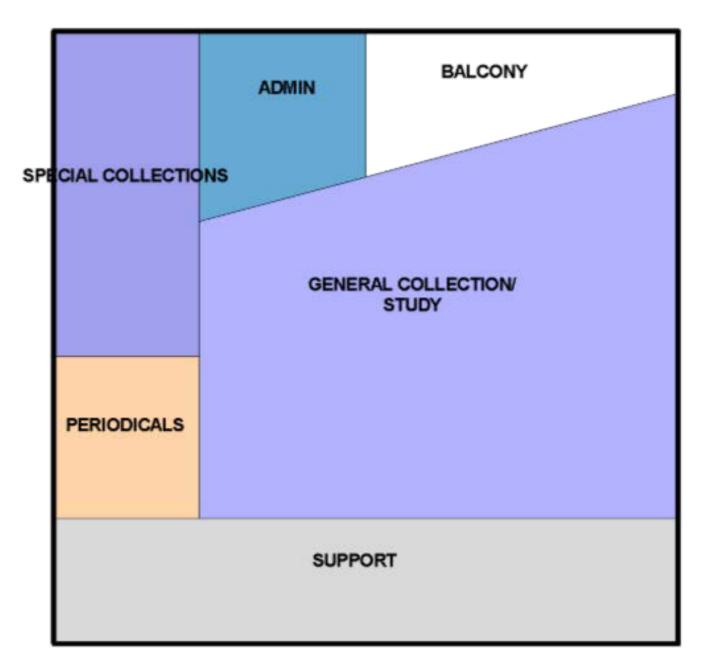

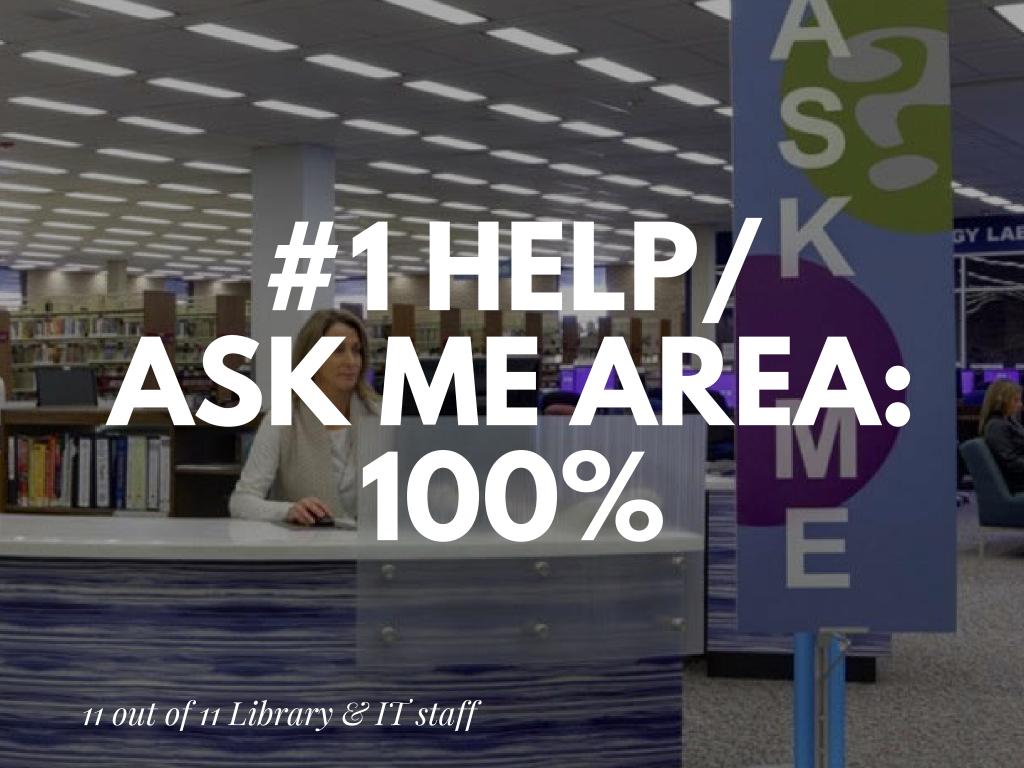

PROJECT BUDGET

The project budget includes site development costs such as 40 parking spaces and an allowance for plaza development; the construction cost of the building - enclosed space and balcony, construction contingency; furniture and equipment and indirect costs which include architectural and engineering fees and material testing etc.

FUNDING HIGHLIGHTS:

Total Building Costs: \$13,670,500

Total Indirect Costs: \$1,270,345

Project Contingency: \$747,042

The current total project budget is: \$15,687,887.
