
Accreditation

- *The University offers degrees in **50** academic programs * 34 of the 50 academic programs are eligible for accreditation by specialized accrediting agencies

Grambling currently offers 50 degree programs at the following levels: I Associate, 32 Bachelors, 13 Master's, 3 Post Master's Certificate (PMC), and 1 Doctoral degree.




