- Undergraduate students are billed \$215 per credit hour.
- Graduate students are assessed tuition rates of \$298.10 per credit hour for each hour enrolled.
- Rounding may affect final calculation of the "Cost Per Hour" X "Full-time Hours".
- International students are assessed a \$65 International Student Service Fee.
- Laboratory fees, nursing fees, and distance learning/Internet course fees are also assessed on specific courses and programs.
- International Students are assessed an international student insurance fee (rates vary depending on your age) per semester. See Foster Johnson Health Center for inquiries.
- Technology fees are billed at \$5.20 per credit hour for undergraduate and graduate students.
- These fees are assessed to each student per semester. The maximum amount is \$60 for all students (undergrad taking more than 16 cr. hrs. and grad taking more than 9 cr. hrs.)
